Mode of study: Full-time (FT)

Programme requirements: 32 written exams during the programme, 1 oral exam at the end, as well as the successful completion of the work placement accompanied by seminars, 1 semester teamwork project supervised by teachers, 1 semester final project optionally in a firm.
